



COVID-19 Screening

Do I meet the screening criteria?

YES

Patients With Symptoms and High Risk

Symptoms include coughing or shortness of breath and/or temperature > 100.4

1

FIRST TESTED FOR THE FLU

Patients with symptoms, pregnant or considered high risk will first be tested for the flu.

2

IF NEGATIVE, COVID-19 TESTED

If flu negative, specimen is sent for COVID-19 testing.



WHO IS HIGH RISK?

Healthcare workers with direct contact with confirmed or suspected COVID case

Pregnant women

Infants < 10 weeks of age/adjusted gestational age.

Patients with immunocompromised conditions (such as receiving immunosuppressive medications, solid organ transplant, hemodialysis, chronic lung disease, active cancer, HIV, diabetes)

60 years of age or older

People living in communal settings (nursing facilities, shelters, etc.)

NO

Patients With NO Symptoms

(Asymptomatic)
