
IT IS ORDERED that an Immediate Temporary Restraining Order is HEREBY GRANTED prohibiting Louisiana State Police, the Lafayette Police Department, and/or Lafayette Consolidated Government and/or any of their agents/employees/assigns from providing the identities of LAFAYETTE POLICE DEPARTMENT OFFICERS JOHN DOE-1, JOHN DOE-2, AND JOHN DOE-3 and/or any statements, documents, reports, and/or audio/video footage captured, maintained, generated, and/or saved regarding the incidents which occurred at the Circle K/Shell Station located at 1912 NE Evangeline Thruway, Lafayette LA 70501, and the Circle K/Shell Station located at 2103 NW Evangeline Thruway, Lafayette LA 70501 on August 21, 2020 to any person, media company/outlet, news organization, and/or other entity not associated with the investigations currently underway by the Lafayette Police Department and Louisiana State Police, respectively, who are conducting concurrent administrative and criminal investigations into the subject event.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Louisiana State Police, the Lafayette Police Department, and/or Lafayette Consolidated Government show cause on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of September <sup>20</sup> ~~2013~~ at 10:00 o'clock A.m. before the Honorable David Smith why an Order of Protection should not be granted prohibiting them Louisiana State Police, the Lafayette Police Department, and/or Lafayette Consolidated Government, and/or any of their agents/employees/assigns from providing the identities of LAFAYETTE POLICE DEPARTMENT OFFICERS JOHN DOE-1, JOHN DOE-2, AND JOHN DOE-3 and/or any statements, documents, reports, and/or audio/video footage captured, maintained, generated, and/or saved regarding the incidents which occurred at the Circle K/Shell Station located at 1912 NE Evangeline Thruway, Lafayette LA 70501, and the Circle K/Shell Station located at 2103 NW Evangeline Thruway, Lafayette LA 70501 on August 21, 2020 to any person, media company/outlet, news organization, and/or other entity not associated with the investigations currently underway by the Lafayette Police Department and Louisiana State

Police, respectively, who are conducting concurrent administrative and criminal investigations into the subject event. Such release of information would impair the integrity of the ongoing investigations and anticipated civil litigation.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT the above captioned record shall be placed under judicial seal and subject to review only by the parties and their respective counsel of record until such time as all administrative, criminal, and civil matters are finally adjudicated, or otherwise settled or completed.
